What we expect:

- Bachelor degree, preferably in economics, business, educational science, teacher training (or similar academic qualification, e. g. university degree with a minimum of 180 ECTS credit points) from a recognized university or institution of higher education
- Complete application documents including the personal motivation letter
- Proof of sufficient knowledge of English (TOEFL, IELTS or similar)
- Preferably work experience in the field of education

Tuition Fees:

The tuition fees for the Master of Educational Management program amounts to € 7200.

Besides that, there is a one-time registration fee of € 250 and an examination fee of € 250.

European Joint Degree Program:

Graduates will receive a European Joint degree from the University of Applied Management (Germany), the Private University College of Education of the Diocese of Linz (Austria) and the Riga Teacher Training and Educational Management Academy (Latvia)
